Powerhouse Celtic Tribal Trio, BROTHER, Reunites at River Rhythms

MILWAUKEE – River Rhythms, downtown Milwaukee’s destination for music on Wednesday evenings, welcomes BROTHER to the stage on Wednesday, June 21st. The free concert series takes place from 6:30-9 p.m. every Wednesday through August 30th (except July 5th) in Pere Marquette Park on Old World Third St. between State and Kilbourn.

Known for their lively and energetic performances, BROTHER, a wholly original Celtic tribal band, headlines this week’s River Rhythms. This is a special performance as BROTHER is reuniting in Milwaukee to perform at River Rhythms after a two-year hiatus. The tribal trio fuses together harmonious vocals with the powerhouse sounds of bagpipes, percussion and didgeridoos.

BROTHER is a nationally acclaimed group and has toured extensively in the United States, Canada, Japan, France, Egypt and Australia, and have shared the stage with artists like Alicia Keys, Joe Walsh, John Entwistle and Linkin Park. BROTHER stands as a leader in the independent scene having self-released 12 albums and sold more CDs in the U.S. than any other Australian act. As a crowd favorite, they will have River Rhythms audience members up and on their feet from beginning to end.
