Milwaukee Indie Band- Soul Low takes the River Rhythms stage this week

Milwaukee, WI— River Rhythms, downtown’s destination for music on Wednesday evenings, welcomes Soul Low to the stage this week, Wednesday, June 15th. The free concert series takes place from 6:30-9 p.m. every Wednesday through August 31st in Pere Marquette Park on Old World Third St. between State and Kilbourn.

Soul Low is a four-piece indie band from Milwaukee who juxtapose wavering vocal pop melodies with introspective and often self-deprecating lyrics. Their nervy, jazz-informed instrumentals offer a familiar yet off-kilter sound reminiscent to Modest Mouse.

In collaboration with Newaukee to further enhance Westtown Wednesdays, the Newaukee Night Market will be taking place from 2nd to 4th street on Wisconsin Avenue tomorrow evening from 5pm- 10pm. Patrons are able to walk between both River Rhythms and the Night Market throughout the evening. The Night Market is a free, open-air market that offers a wide variety of experiences for people of all backgrounds and ages.
